




# Out on a Limb

**Luke 19:2** Now behold, there was a man named Zacchaeus who was a chief tax collector, and he was rich.<sup>3</sup> And he sought to see who Jesus was, but could not because of the crowd, for he was of short stature.<sup>4</sup> So he ran ahead and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see Him, for He was going to pass that way.

**Luke 18:11** “The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, ‘God, I thank You that I am not like other men—extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this tax collector.’”

**Luke 19:8** Then Zacchaeus stood and said to the Lord, “Look, Lord, I give half of my goods to the poor; and if I have taken anything from anyone by false accusation, I restore fourfold.”

**Luke 18:25** “For it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God.”<sup>26</sup> And those who heard it said, “Who then can be saved?”<sup>27</sup> But He said, “The things which are impossible with men are possible with God.”

**2 Peter 3:9** The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

**John 14:6** Jesus said to him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.”

**Romans 10:9** that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

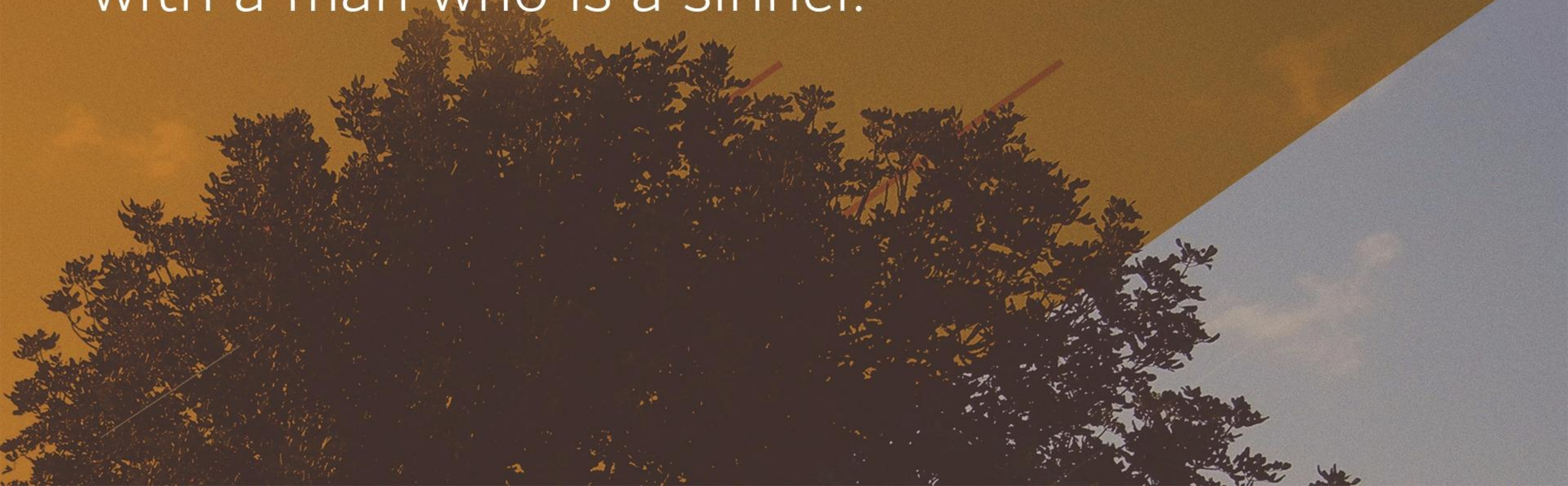
# LONGING FOR JESUS


# —LIVING FOR JESUS—
