Ephesians 3:14-19

Ephesians 3:2 You may have heard of the administration of the grace of God which was given me for you, how by revelation He made known to me the mystery, as I have written briefly already, by which, when you read it, you may understand my knowledge of the mystery of Christ, which in other generations was not made known to the sons of men, as it is now revealed to His holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit, how the Gentiles are fellow heirs, and fellow members, and partakers of the promise in Christ by the gospel.

REVELATION

Ephesians 3:7 Of this I was made a minister, according to the gift of the grace of God given to me by the effective working of His power.8 To me, the very least of all saints, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the incomprehensible riches of Christ, and to reveal for all people what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the ages has been hidden in God, who created all things through Jesus Christ, so that now the manifold wisdom of God might be made known by the church to the principalities and powers in the heavenly places, sour Lord, so the eternal purpose which He completed in Christ Jesus our Lord, so that in Him.

1 Peter 1:10 Concerning this salvation, the prophets who prophesied of the grace that should come to you have inquired and searched diligently, ¹¹ seeking the events and time the Spirit of Christ, who was within them, signified when He foretold the sufferings of Christ and the glories to follow. ¹² It was revealed to them that they were not serving themselves but you, concerning the things which are now reported to you by those who have preached the gospel to you through the Holy Spirit, who was sent from heaven—things into which the angels desire to look.

REVELATION

Luke 15:10 Likewise, I tell you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.

1 John 1:1-2 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have touched, concerning the Word of life—²the life was revealed, and we have seen it and testify to it, and announce to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and was revealed to us...

Hebrews 1:1-3 God, who at various times and in diverse ways spoke long ago to the fathers through the prophets, ²has in these last days spoken to us by His Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, and through whom He made the world. ³He is the brightness of His glory, the express image of Himself, and upholds all things by the word of His power. When He had by Himself purged our sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high.

REVELATION

Matthew 11:25 At that time Jesus said, "I thank You, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because You have hidden these things from the wise and prudent and revealed them to infants. 26 Even so, Father, for it seemed good in Your sight. 27 All things are delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows the Son, except the Father. And no one knows the Father, except the Son and he to whom the Son will reveal Him."

Matthew 11:28 "Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavily burdened, and I will give you rest.²⁹Take My yoke upon you, and learn from Me. For I am meek and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.³⁰For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light."

RELATIONSHIP

Colossians 2:1 I would like you to know what a great struggle I am having for you, and for those at Laodicea, and for everyone who has not seen my face in the flesh, ²that their hearts may be comforted, being knit together in love, and receive all the riches and assurance of full understanding, and knowledge of the mystery of God, both of the Father and of Christ, ³in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. ⁴Now this I say lest anyone beguile you with enticing words.

RELATIONSHIP

Colossians 2:5 For though I am absent in the flesh, yet I am with you in spirit, rejoicing and seeing your orderliness and the steadfastness of your faith in Christ. ⁶As you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him,⁷rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, and abounding with thanksgiving.

RELATIONSHIP

Philippians 4:6 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything, by prayer and supplication with gratitude, make your requests known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will protect your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Finally, brothers, whatever things are true, whatever things are honest, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue, and if there is any praise, think on these things.

RELATIONSHIP

Psalm 139:1 O Lord, You have searched me and known me.²You know when I sit down and when I get up; You understand my thought from far off.³You search my path and my lying down and are aware of all my ways.⁴For there is not a word on my tongue, but behold, O Lord, You know it fully.⁵You put Yourself behind and before me, and keep Your hand on me.⁶Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is lofty, and I cannot fathom it.

RELATIONSHIP

Psalm 139:17 How precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How great is the sum of them!¹⁸If I should count them, they are more in number than the sand; when I awake, I am still with You.

REJOICING

Romans 5:1 Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,²through whom we also have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and so we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.³Not only so, but we also boast in tribulation, knowing that tribulation produces patience, ⁴patience produces character, and character produces hope.⁵And hope does not disappoint, because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

REJOICING

1 Peter 1:6 In this you greatly rejoice, even though now, if for a little while, you have had to suffer various trials, in order that the genuineness of your faith, which is more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tried by fire, may be found to result in praise, glory, and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ, whom, having not seen, you love; and in whom, though you do not see Him now, you believe and you rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory, receiving as the result of your faith the salvation of your souls.

REJOICING

Romans 5:11 Furthermore, we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation.

Psalm 107:1 Oh, give thanks unto the Lord, for He is good, for His mercy endures forever!²Let the redeemed of the Lord speak out, whom He has redeemed from the hand of the enemy,

Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly beyond all that we ask or imagine, according to the power that works in us, to Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen.
