**John 13:10** Jesus said to him, “He who is bathed needs only to wash his feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you.”<sup>11</sup> For He knew who would betray Him; therefore He said, “You are not all clean.”



# THE APOSTLES

**John 13:6** Then He came to Simon Peter. And Peter said to Him, “Lord, are You washing my feet?”<sup>7</sup> Jesus answered and said to him, “What I am doing you do not understand now, but you will know after this.”<sup>8</sup> Peter said to Him, “You shall never wash my feet!” Jesus answered him, “If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me.”

**John 13:9** Simon Peter said to Him, “Lord, not my feet only, but also my hands and my head!”

<sup>10</sup>Jesus said to him, “He who is bathed needs only to wash his feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you.”

**John 13:12** So when He had washed their feet, taken His garments, and sat down again, He said to them, “Do you know what I have done to you?  
<sup>13</sup>You call me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am.<sup>14</sup> If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another’s feet.<sup>15</sup> For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you.
