Psalm 14:1 says that it is the fool who says in his heart that there is no God. What makes this person a fool?

Romans 1:18-23

Verse 19 says that what may be known of God is evident in them, for God has shown it to them. What does that mean?

- Is it necessary that the creator be eternal?
- Is it necessary that the creator be powerful?
- Is it necessary that the creator be divine?

Verse 21 says that they knew God, but the didn't honor Him as God, their minds became fruitless, and their foolish hearts became darkened.

- How did they know God?
- How does a mind become fruitless?
- What is the difference between a mind and a heart?

Verses 22-23 describe something that sounds like people we know today. But who was actually being described?

So, is this a new issue, or has God's Word, His position as Creator, and His authority always been attacked by people like those described in Psalm 14:1?

When we allow ourselves to doubt Genesis, we allow ourselves to doubt God's Word, His position as our Creator, and His Authority in our lives - just like the people described in Romans 1:18-23.
