THE GOSPEL WITH SECURITY

1 Corinthians 15:1-4; Romans 8:31-39

WHAT IS THE GOSPEL?

There a lot of views today as to what the gospel is. Some say it is the love of Jesus. Some say that it is the way we live before others. Some say it is the way treat others. Some say it the acts that we do.

But what does the Bible say it is.

I Corinthians 15:1-4, "Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand; By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain. For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:"

Galatians 1:11-12, "But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man.

For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught it, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ.

- The word "gospel" is defined as:
- "The Good News," or "Glad Tidings."

Good News of what?

- Jesus
- Death
- Burial
- Resurrection

Glad Tidings of what?

- Jesus
- Providing eternal life

- Luke 2:10-11, "And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I
 bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. For unto
 you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the
 Lord."
 - "Good Tidings" is the same word that is used for gospel.
 - There was, is, and never will be any greater news or tidings than to hear that a Savior was born.

John 3:16, "For God so loved the world, that he gave his Only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not Perish, but have Everlasting Life."

What does the Gospel mean to us?

Romans 1:16, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

- Sharing the good news of the gospel is the most important thing any child of God can do.
- The Gospel should mean so much to us that we would want everyone we know to experience what we have.
- Many today are afraid to tell someone about the death, burial, and resurrection because of what others might say about them.

IS THERE SECURITY WITH THE GOSPEL?

"These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God." I John 5:13

"But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name."

John 20:31

What did John 3:16 tell us that we have if we believe?

- Eternal life.
- What is eternal life?
- "Eternal" means "without end, never to cease."

John 5:24, "Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life."

Romans 8:31-39, "What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things? Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth. Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us. Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Il Timothy 1:12, "For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day."
